Call2Recycle:

The Government of Saskatchewan passed *The Household Hazardous Waste Products Stewardship Regulations* (the Regulations) in June 2019, which require industry first-sellers to establish a provincial program for the collection and recycling or safe disposal of several categories of household hazardous waste.

On December 9, 2019, Call2Recycle submitted a product stewardship program (PSP) plan for the management of consumer batteries. Call2Recycle worked closely with the Ministry of Environment to ensure the PSP aligns with the regulatory requirements. The PSP was approved by ministry on April 27, 2020, with the understanding that the regulated battery recycling program will launch on January 1, 2021. Call2Recycle is the only approved program in Saskatchewan. Membership with Call2Recycle ensures compliance with the Regulations. First sellers are encouraged to contact Call2Recycle to better understand their obligations.
