Why Recycle Your Batteries?

To keep harmful materials out of our landfills:

Used batteries ending up in landfill can contain potentially toxic materials that may harm wildlife and the environment.

To keep people & property in our community safe:

Responsible battery recycling practices ensure batteries are handled in a way that reduces potential fire hazards.

To support sustainability & resource conservation:

Materials reclaimed from recycled batteries can be used to make new products.



Bring old batteries to your local municipal recycling depot along with other household recyclables.

- 1. BAG** each battery in a clear, sealable bag.
- 2. Seal** the bag for safe handling.
- 3. Drop** in a collection box or bin at your local municipal location.
