Recycling eBikes at End-of-Life in British Columbia





In British Columbia, sporting equipment with electrical or electronic components, including eBikes, is regulated under the Recycling Regulation Schedule 3, 2 (1)(g). How does the eBike recycling program work?

Riders may choose to have the end-of-life eBike collected at their place of residence. It is also possible the rider will bring the eBike to their local independent bicycle retailer as part of the process of purchasing a new eBike.

Should your business have the opportunity to receive an eBike for recycling, please contact Call2Recycle at 1.888.224.9764 or visit their eMobility recycling webpage at https://www.call2recycle.ca/bc-emobility/. They will arrange for the pick-up of the eBike within 10 business days. This recycling program is funded by an environmental handling fee that may be included in the price of the eBike at the time of purchase.

eBikes will be disassembled in British Columbia. The frames, batteries, drive motors, and electronics will be recycled. Other components may first be reused if in good condition. Otherwise, they too will be recycled.
