

# Call2Recycle gives old batteries new life with easy battery recycling.

## Why is recycling important?

With millions of batteries being bought each year, some of which can contain toxic chemicals and heavy metals, we each have a responsibility to ensure that these materials don't end up in landfills.

Reusing the valuable materials found in batteries to develop new products also helps reduce the need to remove precious and limited natural resources from the earth.

With Call2Recycle®, everyone can play a role in preserving the environment through safe, convenient battery and cellphone recycling.

## How does the program work?

For large quantities or regular shipments, Call2Recycle offers flexible options - postage-paid collection kits (box shipping) or bulk shipping - for collecting and recycling your batteries.

If you have a one-time shipment or less than a bagful, you can simply drop them off at one of Call2Recycle's established collection sites.

All batteries collected are shipped, sorted and recycled by qualified, reputable service providers. New batteries and stainless steel products are made from recovered materials. Nothing ends up in landfills.



## Who is Call2Recycle?

Call2Recycle Canada, Inc. is a not-for-profit, stewardship organization committed to the safe collection, transportation and recycling of consumer batteries across Canada.

In 25 years, the Call2Recycle program has diverted over **40** million kilograms of batteries from local landfills and has established a network of over **10,000** collection locations.

Our mission is to responsibly manage the end-of-life of batteries to keep them out of landfills and minimize environmental impact.

- 93 percent of Canadians live within 15 kilometers of a Call2Recycle drop-off location.
- There are more than 10,000 Call2Recycle collection sites in Canada.
- Nothing makes its way into landfills.
- Over 40 million kilograms collected and recycled in 25 years.
